The Health and Safety Management certification process:

01

PRELIMINARY AUDIT (OPTIONAL)

Initial assessment by the auditors to ascertain the current implementation level of the standard's requirements.

02

CERTIFICATION AUDIT (STAGE 1)

Concentrates on review of general conception of the management system, internal audit, management review, documentation and first site visit.

03

CERTIFICATION AUDIT (STAGE 2)

Concentrates on practical application assessment and evaluation of effectiveness.

04

ISSUING THE CERTIFICATION

Certification of compliance with the standard(s) and commitment to adherence to its requirements. Entry into the online certification database Certipedia.

05

SURVEILLANCE AUDITS

Annual audit of process optimization and compliance with the standards.

06

RECERTIFICATION

Recertification audits take place within three years. Recertification audits will look for evidence of the continuous improvement process.
